


Assessment Item Repository on SLS




- 1. Provides easy access to assessment items for all teachers.
- 2. Fosters a culture of collaboration through sustainable and permanent sharing practices via SLS.
- 3. Increases benefits such as time savings through economies of scale.




2 Features of the Repository

- 1. Created from 1000 school exam papers of various subjects and levels.
- 2. All assessment items are tagged to learning outcomes in the subject content map to enable tracking of students' learning progress and facilitate ease of search.
- 3. Selected papers have Short Answer Feedback Assistant and Feedback Assistant Mathematics enabled to provide immediate feedback and marks.
- 4. Compatible with current and future SLS features, such as auto-marking and the enhanced Authoring Copilot (from Nov 2024) which can adapt existing questions.


Suggested Use Cases

Case 1: Authoring Copilot


 Save questions from the Digitalised Exam Papers as <u>Starred Resources</u>.




2. Create a Module/Section/Activity with Authoring Copilot.




3. Add questions from Starred Resources.



Case 2: Print-to-Scan



- Useful for primary schools and subjects that use pen-and-paper assessment.
- Also works with Short Answer Feedback Assistant!
- 1. Set the Quiz mode to Teacher-Marked and assign it to a Class Group.
- 2. Print the Question Paper and Response Sheets and distribute them.



- 3. After your students have filled in the Response Sheets, scan and upload to the same Class Group.
- <u>Review</u> your students' answers and provide the necessary feedback.
- 5. Click Submit and **Release** to return the results.

Further suggestions for teachers to use the Repository with other SLS features

- **1. For Students' Self-Directed Learning**: Teachers can curate and directly assign these resources as an assignment or add them as <u>Class Group Resources</u> that students can access anytime.
- **2. For Tracking Students' Learning Progress:** Track students' **Learning Progress** to understand their strengths and areas for improvement across topics.
- **3. For Supporting Students' Study Skills:** Use these assessment items with **Quiz Settings** such as Timed Quiz, Quiz Retries and Randomise Pages to develop good time management habits and provide opportunities to reinforce learning.
